Printing/Scanning

When you are at the THI campus you can send a print job to any of the printers in the university network or scans to your university mail address from any end device.

The following printer queues are available:

- KM-STUD-sw black/white printing on Konica-Minolta.
- color printing on Konica-Minolta.

 Go to the selected printer and use your student ID card for authentication to activate your print job.

Printing credit

KM-STUD-color

- Current printing credit can be checked by double-clicking the € symbol in the task bar on all public computers at the university.
- The electronic purse of the student ID card can be used to increase printing credit at the **charging terminals** (e. g. in library foyer).

Charging terminal

All payments at the university are made cashless using the charging terminals. Examples of the services provided at these terminals include:

- Recharging your printing account
- Paying for transcripts of records
- Paying for course fees
- Purchasing software

Student ID card

Activating user account

Your personal IT account allows a single login for many various university services. You will receive your account information with an initial password via the application portal. To activate your account, sign either on a computer of the THI or Outlook Webmail.

Important: There is no possibility of using IT service without changing the initial password!
