What can I find in Science Direct?

- The database provides scientific articles and book chapters from the following fields: Physical Sciences and Engineering, Life Sciences, Health Sciences and Social Sciences and Humanities.
- The texts are available partly as full texts, partly only as bibliographic references.

How can I access Science Direct?

- Go to the library's website:

- Select **Electrical and Mechanical Engineering, Computer Sciences** → **Science Direct**.

Search/result list

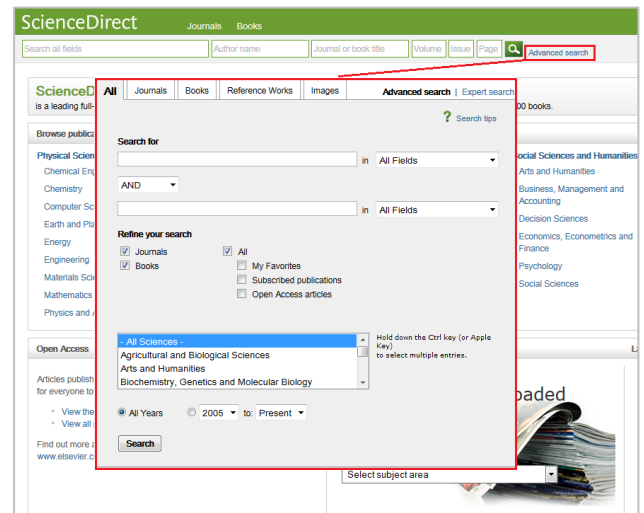
- Click on **Advanced Search** to start your search.
- In the result list, different possibilities for further use are available to you:



- With an individual result displayed, there is an outline of the result on the left side to navigate through the document.
- On the right side, you can display references of texts that are closely thematically related (**Citing and recommended articles**).
- Under **My settings** and **My alerts**, you have the possibility to personalise the use of the database.
