Target group

The qualification programme is addressing refugees

- who couldn't finish their study course in their home country
- whose study course degree isn't recognised in Germany
- with 12 years of school and high-school education

Not included in the target group are refugees in reception or deportation centres, similar institutions as well as refugees from so-called safe countries.

Admission requirements

- University entrance qualification
- Proficiency in English (A2 - B1 CEFR)
- Refugee status
